Tips on Registering and Voting

Can you vote in Ohio?	To be eligible to vote in Ohio, you must: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Be at least 18 years old on or before Election Day• Be a U.S. citizen• Be an Ohio resident for at least 30 days• NOT be declared incompetent to vote by a probate court• NOT be imprisoned for a felony conviction• NOT be permanently disqualified for violating an election law
Are you registered to vote in Ohio?	Find out here
If you are not registered: Spanish Voter Registration Form English Voter Registration Form	<p>- Eligible voters can register by mail or in person. Online registration is not an option.</p> <p>- To register, take or send a completed Voter Registration and Information Update Form to your local county Board of Elections Office.</p> <p>-If you would rather pick up a copy of this form, a list of locations is available here</p> <p>- Once you have completed the Voter Registration and Information Update Form, you can drop it off to any of the following locations:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Board of Elections Offices• Ohio public library• Ohio BMV Deputy Registrar Office• Any public high school or vocational school• County treasurer office and other state offices
Can I make changes to my registration?	All voters are required to submit any changes in name or address 30 days prior to election. This can be done online , in person or by mail. Changes must be submitted to your local county Board of Elections .
Can I vote using an absentee ballot? Spanish form English form	Voters can send in their absentee vote by mail. All ballots must either be post-marked before Election Day or delivered in person to county boards of election on Election Day.

¿Puede votar usted en Ohio?	Para ser elegible a votar en Ohio, usted debe: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Be at least 18 years old on or before Election Day• Be a U.S. citizen• Be an Ohio resident for at least 30 days• NOT be declared incompetent to vote by a probate court• NOT be imprisoned for a felony conviction• NOT be permanently disqualified for violating an election law

Si no está registrado: Formulario de Registro de Votante English Voter Registration Form	Los votantes elegibles pueden registrar por correo o en persona. El registro en línea no es una opción. <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Para registrarse, llene el formulario Spanish Voter Registration Form y lleve a su Junta Electoral Local- Si prefiere recoger el formulario en persona, puede hacerlo en estos lugares- Una vez que haya llenado el Formulario de Registro de Votante o Actualización de Registro Actual, lo puede depositar en cualquiera de los lugares a continuación:<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Board of Elections Offices (Juntas Electorales)• (Biblioteca Pública)• Ohio BMV Deputy Registrar Office (Registro Publico Vehicular)• (Cualquier colegio de secundaria o escuela vocacional)• Oficina del Tesorero en su condado o cualquier otra oficina estatal
¿Puedo hacer cambios a mi registro de votante?	Todos los votantes deben enviar cualquier cambio(s) de nombre o dirección 30 días antes de la elección. Se puede hacer en línea , en persona o por correo. Los cambios deben ser enviados a la Junta Electoral de su Condado .
¿Puedo votar usando una boleta para elector ausente? English form	Los electores pueden enviar su boleta para elector ausente por correo. Todas las boletas deben estar fechadas con el sello del correo antes del día de las elecciones, o deberán ser entregadas en persona en la Junta Electoral del Condado en el día de las elecciones.
