	Commit to providing information and resources for voter registration and education at every event you host starting on 5 de Mayo through Hispanic Heritage Month (Sept 15-Oct 15).
	Set a goal for your organization on the numbers of voters you will register
	Select a special event/opportunity for your internal kick off (could be a team meeting, special community event, board meeting, etc.)
	Set up voter registration tables at every event you host and in your office
	Engage with the local board of elections to host informational sessions, voter registration training, how to conduct a voter registration drive, vote by mail application and other electronic tools
	Educate your staff and inform voters how to update their existing information if needed. Consider including a message on your telephone greeting encouraging people to register
	Remind voters about different options available for them to cast a ballot, including early voting, vote by mail or voting on Election Day
	Plan a special event around National Voter Registration Day (September 26,2016)
	Coordinate efforts on Election Day to ensure all voters make it to their precincts
	Add information on your websites with links about how to register to vote, where to vote, FAQ, etc. (see resource list)
	Include a tagline on your email signatures to encourage everyone to register to vote
	Report all events where voter registration/education is taking place to OCHLA for our statewide campaign.
	Use social media and your website to educate the community. Ask employees to engage through their social media networks. Ask everyone to help!
