Distinguished Hispanic Ohioan Award

Qualifications:



- Hispanic or Latino/a ancestry
- An individual with at least two years of community service whose contributions under consideration for this award are above and beyond one's job duties, obligations, or of exceptional benefit to Ohioans
- Ties with a Latino community organization
- An Ohio resident, or performed service of great, tangible benefit to Ohioans
- Of good character and community standing, exhibiting leadership

Nuestra Familia Award

Qualifications:



- Of ancestry that is NOT Hispanic or Latino/a
- An individual, company, or other type of organization
- At least two years of community service
- An Ohio-based person or group, or performed service of exceptional benefit to the Latino community in Ohio
- Of good character and community standing, exhibiting leadership.

Latino Military Service of Distinction Award

Qualifications:



- Continues to contribute to their community, state, and country in an exemplary manner.
- Hispanic or Latino/a ancestry
- A resident of Ohio or lived in Ohio during military service.
- If applicable: received an honorable discharge from the U.S. Armed Forces.
