



Dr. Margaret Stager is the Director of the Division of Adolescent Medicine at MetroHealth Medical Center. In this role, Dr. Stager is responsible for the teaching and training of medical students and residents in the practice of Adolescent Medicine. The Adolescent Medicine Clinic serves teens and young adults from ages 12-26 years and includes services such as annual medical exams, sports physicals, reproductive health care, screening for drug and alcohol problems, diagnosis of eating disorders, management of teen obesity, and other common adolescent conditions such as acne, asthma, and allergies.

Dr. Stager's research interests include safety and efficacy trials for teen vaccines DepoProvera contraception, and the effect of text messaging on improving vaccination rates. Dr. Stager has held leadership positions both regionally and nationally. Currently she serves on the Adolescent Health Committee for the Ohio AAP.
