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Policy on parental and foster caregiver involvement in schools.

- Each local school board shall adopt a policy on parent and family engagement in the schools in the district.
- The Ohio State Board of Education will adopt recommendations for the development of a parent involvement policy.

Ohio State Board Policy

Parent and Family Involvement

“The State Board of Education of Ohio recognizes parents and families as children’s first and most important teachers. When parents enroll their children in school, from preschool through high school, the responsibility of education and care is shared with the school and the community. Partnerships among families, schools and communities that are child-centered and family-strengthening can engage, guide and motivate students to be productive citizens in a global society.”

Title 1, Part A Requirements

Family Engagement

If a local school district receives at least \$500,000 in Title 1, Part A funding, at least 1% of the funding must be set-aside for family engagement activities.

Title 1 family engagement Funds

How can local school districts spend their Title 1 family engagement dollars?

- Presenters and materials for events about how parents can help their children with academics, social emotional wellbeing, college and career readiness and other relevant topics.
- Some districts hire a parent coordinator
- All districts are required to have at least one yearly activity to involve families.

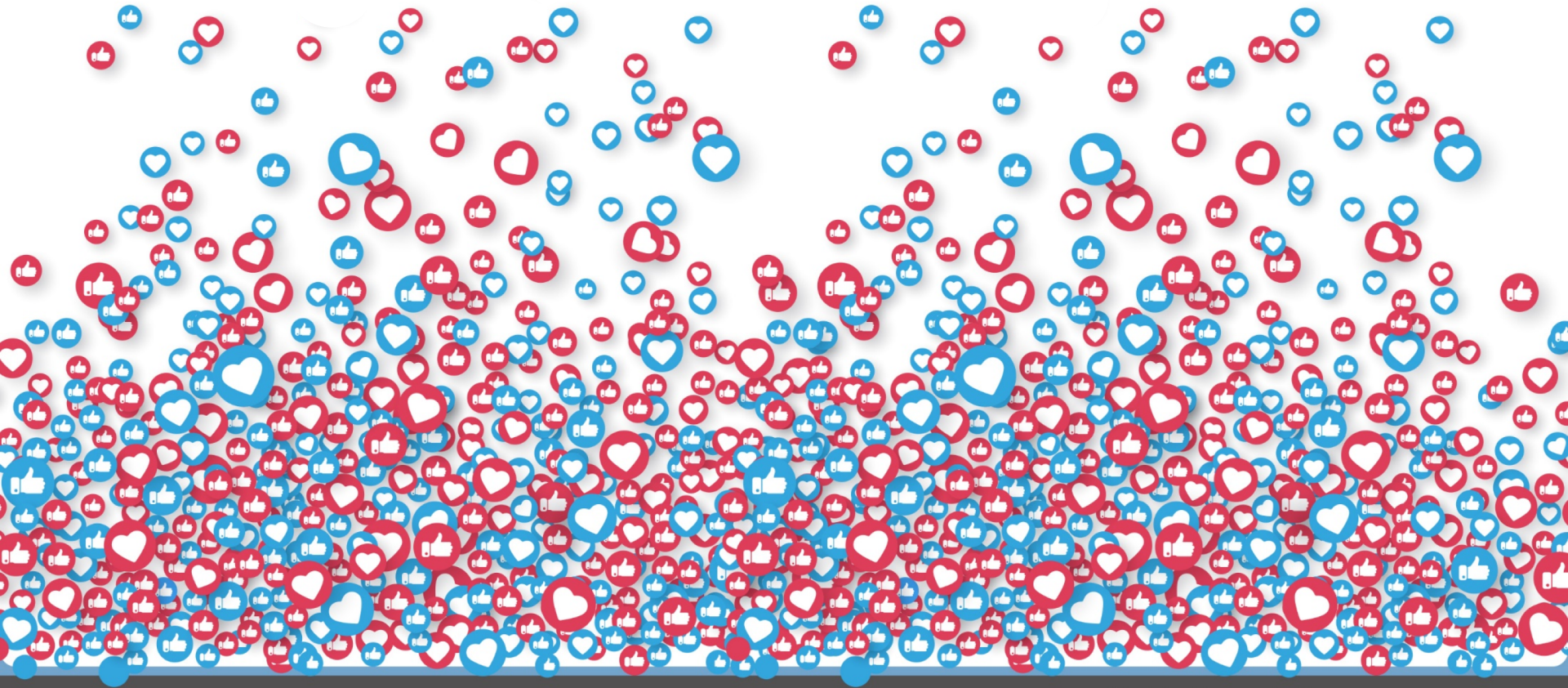
